I learned to quilt in 1979 as soon as my youngest was in pre-school. I was able to take classes through the community college and learned so many techniques that I've used all these years. Now I'm trying to adopt some new ideas, especially all those crazy rulers?! I always found time to quilt but these last few years have been very prolific for me. That's what happens when the kids are grown.

Most of my quilts are made pieced and made for everyday use. I use flannel on most backs. Cuddle factor. I do love applique and embroidery so wall quilts are all over my house.

I wondered why I was picked for featured quilter as I don't feel like one. But maybe that is why. I think my quilts are beautiful but simple. We can all make them!

Quilts made and quilted by Olivia

- 1) Kim Diehl Happy. 64x64. I love making these quilts with a combination of applique and piecing. Quilted by Material Handlers.
- 2) Paper me Happy 40x40. A paper piecing sampler taught by Alex Anderson. Not much of a paper piecer but love this little gem.
- 3) Cottage Charm 54x56 Saw many cute example of this quilt and had to join the fun. Fun to use these Kaffe fabrics and dramatic black background.
- 4) Yo Yo Fun. My latest return to Kim Diehl patterns. This one had it all plus got to use some of my civil war fabrics. Custom quilted by Ann Pear-son.
- 5) House Among the Stars 62x70. This quilt is a Blackbird design. I loved using these beautiful Moda fabrics. Through the years of quilting my taste has changed in design as well as color. My favorites are still these gentle colors. Quilted by Material Handlers.
- 6) Civil War Circles 47x62 This Quilt is an old Fons and Porter pattern. They did produce a kit for this quilt but I chose to use my own fabric. Laurie Sengo at Cloth Carousel helped me pick out the border. It is mostly hand pieced and hand quilted.
- 7) Black and White—Oh My! 58x58 This is my rebellious period. I think we all tried something new during our shut-down. Mine were easy and colorful quilts. Who can you resist these Tula Pink beauties.
- 8) Romantic Flight. 70x72. This is a Blackbird design. I saved scraps of my favorite early Moda florals. I saw these butterflies and knew my scraps had found a home. Quilted by Material Handlers.
- 9) Quilters Delight 62x62 I made this for my son because he liked midcentury design. This color choice didn't work for him. Well my husband loves it. It hangs in our hallway often. Quilted by Gina Boyd
- 10) Baskets in Red. 45x54 So many wonderful classes and sew-alongs during the pandemic. This was a sew along with Alex Anderson. Challenge to use one main color. I do love red. Finding this border print in my stash was the icing on the cake. Quilted by Ann Pearson

Olivia Loop curated the fabric selection and oversaw the construction of the quilt.
