It is a 12 inch block - please make two blocks. The fabric colors for the blocks are:

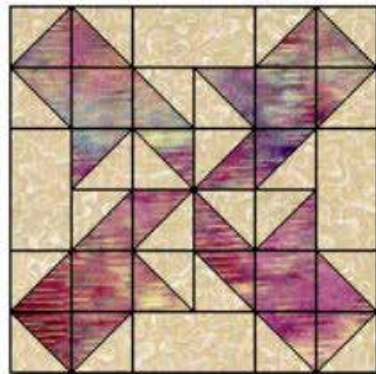
Fabric 1: Dark Rose color

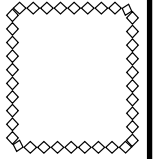

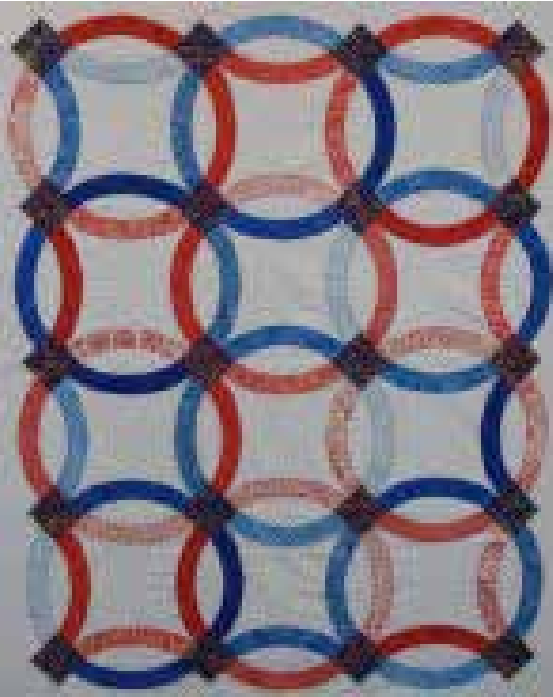
